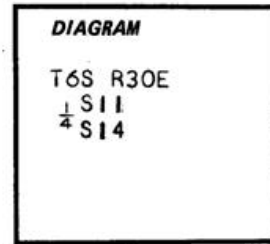


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

ALL BT'S HAVE A RED-PAINTED STRIPE, BEARING TREE TAGS, AN ATTENTION TAG, AND A BRASS WASHER STAMPED PLS 346 NAILED TO THE LOWER BLAZE. THERE IS A STEEL FENCE POST NEAR THE CORNER.
